

Roman Catholicism had its own ways to cover up for this kind of crimes. They are never reported, they are reported to bishop then nothing happens, priests caught in the act are moved from parish to parish and "the life goes on". Many politicians in Poland and different high ranking officials are Roman Catholic, so it was not easy to investigate their

"beloved church".

Now 3 things happened in Poland to awake this sleepy nation. Now many Poles are shocked and many for maybe the first time started to

question their "church".



1) Polish Bishops' Conference presented 1st report. From January 1, 1990 to June 30, 2018 (roughly 28 years): 625 children, hundreds of perpetrators (382 priests).



2) Tomasz and Marek Sekielski produced 2 movies: "Tell no one" (2019) and "Playing hide and seek" (2020). First one has over 24 million views, the second over 8 million. Polish audience was deeply shocked












3) **Polish Bishops' Conference** presented 2nd report. From July 1, 2018 to December 31, 2020 (now only 2,5 years). Now it took only 2,5 years to report abuse of 386 kids. ALSO let us notice something important: During the whole year of COVID-19 year, 2020 people reported crimes against kids in Poland.



Now a little bit of statistics:

1st Report:



"The data received by the Secretariat of the Polish Bishops' Conference from all dioceses and orders shows that the total number of victims under 15 years old was 345 in all - also unconfirmed - cases. There were 280 victims over 15 years of age. Among the victims, in all reported cases, male minors totaled 58.4%, and female minors 41.6%." wiadomosci.dziennik.pl/

2nd Report:

"As stated, the division of victims between boys and girls is almost equal. In both age groups, the share of boys and girls was the same (50% each). - 28 percent of reports concerned the use of altar servers, 19 percent of students, schoolgirls and people prepared for the sacraments, 17 percent of community pastoral care participants, 7 percent of choir members, 7 percent of the clergyman's family or circle of friends" wiadomosci.dziennik.pl

Conclusions:

1) It took 28 years to amass 625 victims, then it took only 2,5 years for number of abused kids to reach 386. It gives us 154 victim per year and in 28 years it should be about **4323** victims not 625.

Conclusions:

2) Abuse took place also during COVID-19 pandemic.



Conclusions:

3) In 1st report almost 60% of victims were male, 40% female. In 2nd report, it was 50/50. Problems with perversion.

Conclusions:

4) While Poles watched 2 aforementioned movies "Tell no one" and ""Playing hide and seek" abuse kept going on. No remorse.

Conclusions:

5) Bear in mind, victims are being brainwashed not to report the crime, they face ostracism for themselves and family, many people will still not believe them. It's also a matter of private shame.


6) While victims of similar crimes were awarded millions of dollars in USA, in Poland they still may receive a fraction of the money.





Conclusions:

7) If we analyze stats, we can see that they try to hide the truth. They try to minimize the impact. Current data may be just a tip of the big iceberg well hidden from the prying eyes of the public.
